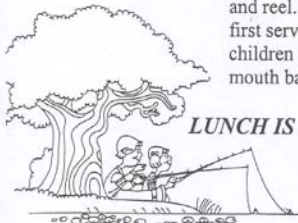

The Hatchery pond is stocked with large-mouth bass, catfish, sunfish and crappie.
